GCSE Results Headlines

- 86% of students gained grades 9 to 4 in Maths (equivalent to the old grade C or above)
- · 84% of students gained grades 9 to 4 in English (Language or Literature).
- · 32% of all Maths GCSE graded 9 to 7 (equivalent to the old A*/A)
- 28% of English GCSE graded 9 to 7
- · 80% of all GCSE entries graded 9 to 4
- 28% of all GCSE entries graded 9 to 7 (or A*/A)
- 15% of all GCSE entries graded at 9 or 8 (or A*)
- 6% of all GCSE entries graded at 9
- · 79% of students gained at least 5 grades 9 to 4
- · 73% of students gained at least 5 grades 9 to 4 including English and Maths
- Progress 8 score will be positive for the 4th consecutive year (every year since the new measure was introduced)

Official Progress 8 scores are not calculated and released by the DFE until October/November.

A Level Results

- · Average points per entry is 38.5
- · 12% of all A level entries graded A* (8% nationally)
- · 38% of all A level entries graded A* to A (27% nationally)
- 63% of all A level entries graded A* to B (52% nationally)
- 98% of all A level entries graded A* to E (97% nationally)
- · 100% of students got into their university of choice; 46% at Russell Group Universities
