• <u>KIT LIST</u>

Students will travel to Ipswich in their training kit with a tracksuit over the top. Students will require casual clothes for the evening at Ipswich as well as for the football match. They will need warm clothing and a coat.

For the coaching experience they will require their outdoor blue PE kit – navy reversible, navy TGS shorts and navy TCS football socks. The practice pitch at Portman Road is a fieldturf 3G, so Astro trainers, moulded boots or trainers are required. **No blades or screw-ins are allowed.**

For the football tournament on the Saturday morning, students will be able to wear a football shirt of their choice!

Students will require toiletries for their stay and may also wish to bring a towel.

LUGGAGE

Each person is allowed one piece of luggage for the hold of the coach plus one piece of hand luggage for the coach journey. However, all luggage will need to be carried from Portman Road to the hotel (ten minute walk).

<u>MONEY</u>

Students will need money for breakfast, lunch and tea on the return journey. They may also require money for souvenirs, drinks etc during the visit. Money for the restaurant, cinema and tournament will be collected prior to the visit.

<u>CODE OF CONDUCT</u>

The visit should be a positive, enjoyable and rewarding time. The following code of conduct is expected throughout the visit:

- No noisy and disruptive behaviour in the accommodation we will not be the only people in the hotel.
- Rooms to be kept clean and tidy.
- Be punctual at all times.
- Follow instructions at all times.
- No drinking alcohol, smoking, taking illegal substances etc.

In circumstances when the code of conduct is broken, students may be removed from the activity and supervised at all times by a member of staff.

In circumstances when a serious breach of the code of conduct has occurred and a student(s) cannot be trusted and puts the group in danger, parents will be informed.

• <u>FOOD</u>

The accommodation is on a room only. Students will need to pre-order their evening meal.

MEDICATION

If you take any medication, this must be handed to Mr Punt in the Bus Park at school. Please label it clearly with the name, purpose and how often and when it is to be taken. If you suffer from travel sickness please take your medication in sufficient time for it to be effective during any journey. During the visit, in exceptional circumstances, I will provide paracetamol to students for pain relief. If you do not wish me to give your son paracetamol please let me know in writing before departure.

MOBILE PHONES & VALUABLES

If you have to bring anything of value (e.g. mobile phone, ipods etc.) please take extreme care of it. Students should not use mobile phones during specific times as instructed by the members of staff.

• ID CARDS

Students will be provided with an identification card. This will provide details of the accommodation's address and telephone number as well as the emergency contact number for the visit. **Students must carry this at all times in case of an emergency.**

HEALTH & SAFETY

It is essential that students listen carefully to instructions. Information and instructions are given for the safety of everyone and must be adhered to at all times.

HEAD COUNTS

Students will be allocated a head count group. This will be used frequently during the visit.
