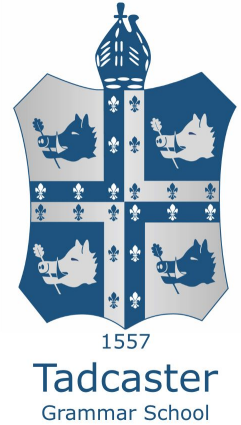

Dear Parents and Carers

- **Consent for use of images**
- **Consent for Educational visits**
- **Medical emergency consent**

I recently contacted you with regards to the school change in Management Information System (MIS). As a result of this change, to a system called 'Bromcom', we are required to approach you to confirm your consent for the use of images of your child, and also confirm that we have your consent for your child to attend routine educational visits or sporting fixtures. In extremely rare cases it may also be necessary for your child to be given emergency medical treatment whilst at school or on an educational visit, and we do need consent for this as well.

Prior to any visits away from school you will receive details such as the nature of the visit, location, timings and travel arrangements, and you can inform the school if you do not wish your child to participate in any particular visit or activity.

As a result in a change to the law relating to Data Protection, incorporating GDPR, we will need parents to affirm that they agree, and if we do not receive a response we will assume that you do NOT give such consent. It is therefore extremely important that you do respond to the consent form if you wish your child to participate in any of the activities listed on the form, to the use of images of your child, or emergency medical treatment.
