Key Stage 4 Options Evening: Thursday 9 January 2019

The time is fast approaching when we ask students in Year 9 to choose their option subjects to study during Years 10 and 11.

The curriculum followed by our students consists of a core of subjects which all students must study. These are English, Mathematics, Science, Religious Education, Physical Education and Life Skills. In addition, students choose three subjects from a list of options.

On Thursday 9 January, I will be hosting the Option Choices Evening, beginning at 6.30pm in the Main Hall, to which all parents and students are invited. It will be an opportunity to gain a full understanding of the options process and to ask questions.

To help the students in this decision-making, teachers will shortly be advising them of the course content in individual subjects. Students can also request careers interviews to gain more bespoke guidance from our Careers Advisor. (careers@tgs.starmat.uk).

I trust that you will find the information booklet which will be issued to students early in January, helpful and I do hope that you are able to attend the evening. I look forward to being able to guide you through this process which will, for many students, be the first major life choice they will make.
