**Information For Parents, Carers and Students: Provision For Year 10 From Monday 15th June 2020**

We are very much looking forward to seeing Year 10 students in school again. As you know, each student will be attending lessons for one morning per week (9.30 - 11.30) and the time in school will be aimed at supporting students with their remote learning. The day each student has been allocated will not change before the end of term.

Students should only attend school on the day detailed in the table below, organised according to their Maths group.

A very small number of students who do not fit into the table below have already been informed about their individual arrangements.

Lessons will begin at 9.30am and students should not arrive at school before 9.15am.

Students will have three remote learning support sessions for Maths, English and Science during their morning in school each week.

The three sessions will end at 11.30am and students should have left the school site by 11.45am at the latest.

The class groups students have been placed in are based on Maths teaching groups. This has been done so the work covered in school will be appropriate for their tier of entry. Due to the restrictions on mixing, we cannot reorganise students into their English and science sets, however the English and science teachers will provide support and guidance relevant to the remote learning work that has been set in these subjects.

**We will email students before Friday 12th June to let them know which classroom they will be located in for all their time in school until the end of term.**

In school things will be very different to a normal school day, so we have put some important information onto the posters below. Please read these very carefully to ensure that you all

understand how school will work from next week. It is very important that all students attending school on their allocated day follow these expectations. We will all have to follow them to ensure everyone's safety.

Students should wear their normal school uniform, *minus* the blazer, jumper and tie.

If a student is coming into school by bus you can contact your provider for details of pick up times. However, once the transport providers have finalised their revised times we will also post this information on the school website.

If a student is unable to attend on their allocated day, please contact the school using the attendance phone line or attendance email: [attendance@tgs.starmat.uk](mailto:attendance@tgs.starmat.uk). Please give full details about why a student is not in school. We are required to pass on information if a student is a suspected or a confirmed case of COVID 19, so the appropriate support and advice can be provided and the correct procedures followed in school.

## Before setting off



Equipment - pens, pencils, ruler, calculator. You will not be able to borrow anything at school.



Drink - bring a bottle of water with you. There will be nowhere to refill your bottle or get drinks at school.



Books - please bring your Maths, English and Science exercise books.



Food - please do not bring any food to school. No food will be available to buy at school.



Do not come in to school if you are feeling unwell. Please contact school to let us know.



If you are going to travel to school on public transport please follow Government rules about using face coverings. You will have to sit in socially distanced seats.

## At all times



Please remember that deliberately breaking rules designed to protect staff and student safety can not be tolerated.

## Arriving at school



Please do not arrive at school before 9.15am. Lessons start at 9.30am



If arriving by car, bike or walking please go **straight to your classroom**. A member of staff will be there to direct you.



If arriving by bus please wait on the bus until a **member of staff** asks you to go to your classroom.



Social distancing - always remain **at least 2m away** from staff and other students. You will need to use the markers on the ground to help you keep your distance.

## Lessons

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There is sanitizer outside of your classroom. You must use it before going into the room and if you leave and return to the room.



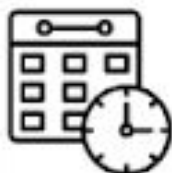
If you start to feel unwell at school please let a member of staff know **immediately**.



Please only go to the classroom you have been allocated. You are not allowed into any other classroom.



Each student has been allocated a desk. Please sit at your desk and avoid touching anything else in the classroom.



You will have 3 lessons per day in the same classroom. The teachers will come to you. There is no 'breaktime'.



Our usual high standards of behaviour are expected. You must follow **all** staff requests.



"Catch it, Bin it, Kill it" - use a tissue when coughing/sneezing and then place it in the bin.



Each class has an assigned toilet block to use to avoid mixing with students from other groups.

## Leaving school

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Lessons end at 11.30am



Social distancing - always remain **at least 2m away** from staff and other students.



Teachers will let you leave the classroom one at a time to help ensure social distancing.



Take all your belongings home with you. Anything left in the classroom will be safely disposed of.



Go **straight** to you bus, car, bike. Please **do not** wait for your friends.
