## **Statutory Courses**

ALL students will study:

- English Language and English Literature (2 GCSEs)
- Mathematics (1 GCSE)
- Science (up to 3 GCSEs)
- RE Philosophy & Ethics (1 GCSE)
- Physical Education (can also be an option)
- Life Skills (includes Citizenship, Careers & PSHCE)

This can lead to 7 GCSEs

# Decisions, Decisions......

Now it is time to choose your other 3 subjects

You need to think carefully about:

- new challenges and opportunities
- previous successes in each subject area
- types of assessment in each course (read the booklet!)
- your future career options (but not too much......)
- what you enjoy most!

### Do *NOT* consider:

- what your friends are planning to do
- which teachers you like this year

# What are the *types* of course on offer?

Most courses here at TGS are GCSEs, which are graded 1 - 9.

(9 being the top grade)

# ...but there are other equally useful qualifications too....

- Cambridge Nationals
- Technical Awards
- NCFE Certificates
- BTEC qualifications

# It is just a different journey.....

BTEC Grades		GCSE	equivalent
Distinction* (Level 2)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	8.5
Distinction (Level 2)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	7
Merit (Level 2)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	5.5
Pass (Level 2)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	4
Distinction (Level 1)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	3
Merit (Level 1)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	2
Pass (Level 1)	is equiva	lent to a GCSE grade	1.25

Most GCSEs have exams at the end of Year 11. Many of the other courses have 'modules' or 'units' which add up to a final grade. Some of these will be taken in Year 10. They all add up to the same thing.

**GCSEs** Year 11 Year 10 **BTECs** 

In some subject areas there is a choice between GCSE and other types of qualification:

### For example, you might choose to study

Art & Design GCSE or Art & Design BTEC

Business Studies GCSE or Business Studies (Enterprise) BTEC

PE GCSE or Sport Studies Cambridge National

Drama GCSE or Performing Arts BTEC

Music GCSE or Technology for Music Practitioners Level 2

Food Preparation or Hospitality & Catering Level 2

staff within each subject area will give guidance

### What is the EBacc? Should I do this?

The EBacc or 'English Baccalaureate' is not a qualification in itself, but represents your achieving a qualification in:

- English Language & Literature
- Maths
- Science (triple or combined)
- A Modern Foreign Language
- Geography or History

It may be that you feel that this broad range of subjects suits you, and provides you with a strong foundation for further studies post 16. It is your choice.

We will do our very best to offer every student the courses they select, but....


 Some combinations of subjects might not fit into the timetable. If there is a 'clash', you will need to select a different course.


