Dear Parents, Carers & Students,

I hope this finds you well? As we approach the Christmas break, I am writing with a number of updates which should assist your planning.

You may already be aware from the media that secondary schools have been directed by the government to supervise testing for Covid-19 with all students upon their return to school in January 2022. This will be the nasal swab test. We are currently designing our response to this expectation to supervise the testing of our 1504 students under appropriate infection control measures which is likely to involve a change to the first day of term, Tuesday 4th January 2022 (Monday 3rd January 2022 is a Bank Holiday, school will be closed). I will write again as soon as our plans are completed, along with details of how to book a supervised Covid-19 LFD test in school for your child(ren).*

Supervised asymptomatic testing of students in school is exceptionally labour intensive. If any parents or relatives would like to volunteer to assist with the administration and/or actual LFD testing at school on Tuesday 4th January 2022, please could I ask you to contact Mr I Webb (Business Manager) on <u>i.webb@tgs.starmat.uk</u> by Monday 13th December 2021 at the latest.

Finally, a reminder that our current term will finish at 1.30 pm on Friday 17th December 2021. The break and lunch catering service will run as normal.
