#### **Which Chromebook?**

established have We working partnership with a well established education provider, technology and parents can opt into a **VOLUNTARY** scheme purchase a chromebook for their child through them. Alternatively they can provide their own device, and simply purchase a chromebook licence (around £30) which allows it to be 'managed' within the school's Google domain.

Those students without a chromebook of their own will be loaned one for use throughout the school week.



#### **How The Device Is Funded**

Parents and carers can opt to buy a chromebook outright, or commit to fixed monthly payments, and spread the cost over time with no personal credit check required.

The scheme offers an extended warranty and a quick and free accidental damage repair service too.
