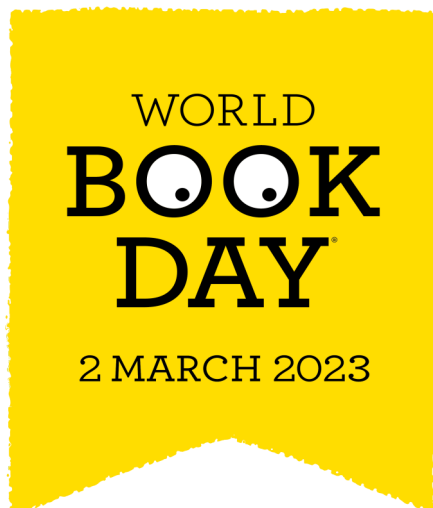


World Book Day:

Write down your answers, along with your name and form and pop it in the box. In case of a tie, winners will be drawn from the box.



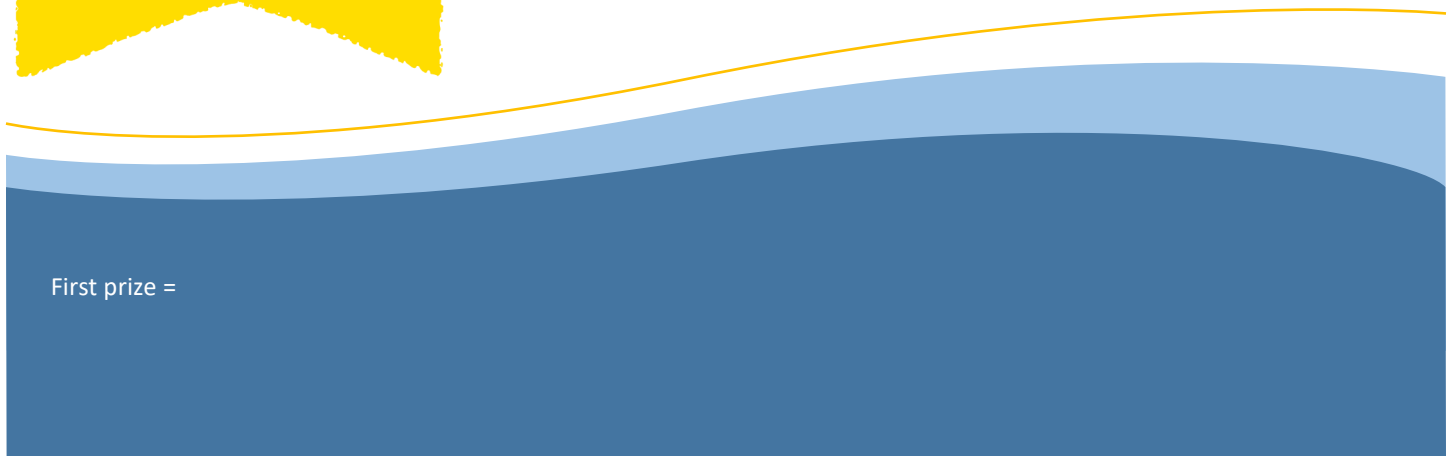
