FAQs

What happens at the end of the agreement?

Will there be any credit checks?

What is the excess on the warranty and repair service?

How do I make a warranty or accidental damage claim?

You will be provided with a clear policy document detailing how to make a claim.

Can students use it at home?

Yes. Students can use it as their own personal device at home.

What happens if I miss a payment or can no longer afford the device?

You will have to return the device; you do not own the device until the final payment is made.

What if my child leaves the School?

You must return the device to the School or alternatively pay the outstanding payments to take ownership of the device.
